

Here is an instruction how to fold a paper bag

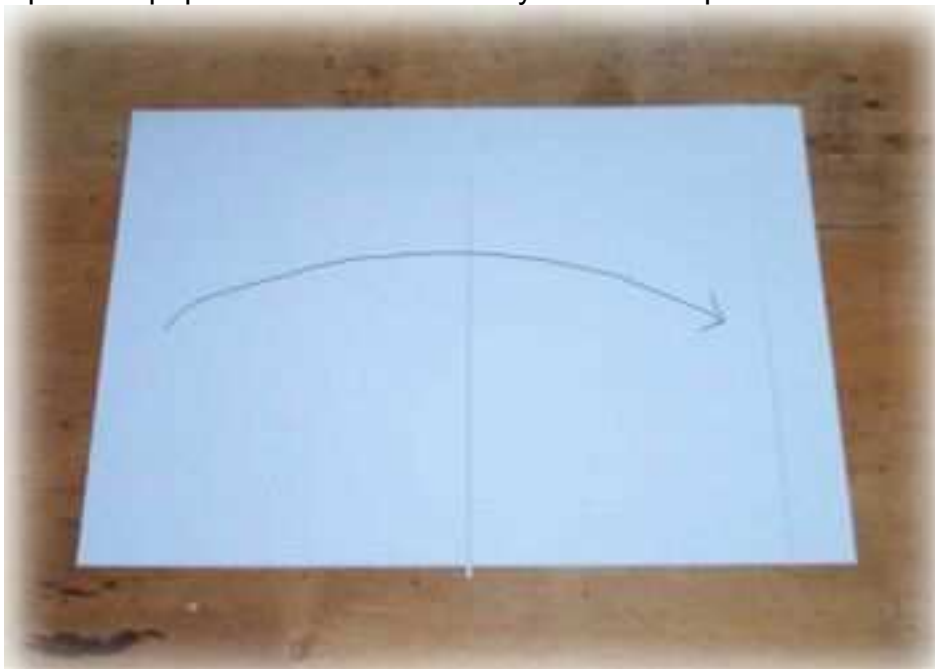
I used this instruction to fold some bags for a photo shooting with Rosemarie and Otto lonker for the latest book with fashion dolls. I scanned a picture of it to show you.



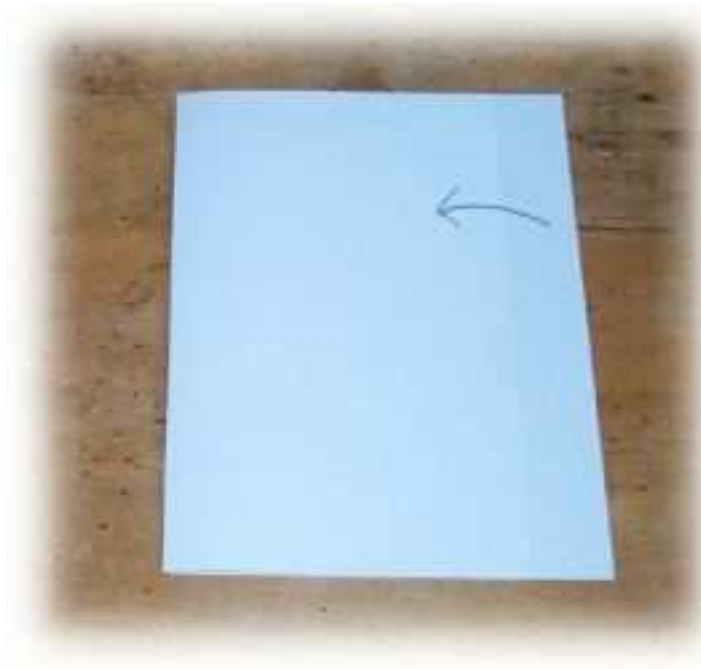
For dresses from the 1960th shown in Rosemaries book I crafted paperbags. I've chosen a beautiful picture of Audrey Hepburn to embellish the bag.

Make your own individual paper bag. Maybe you like to add a logo of your favourite designer or a picture of your doll.....

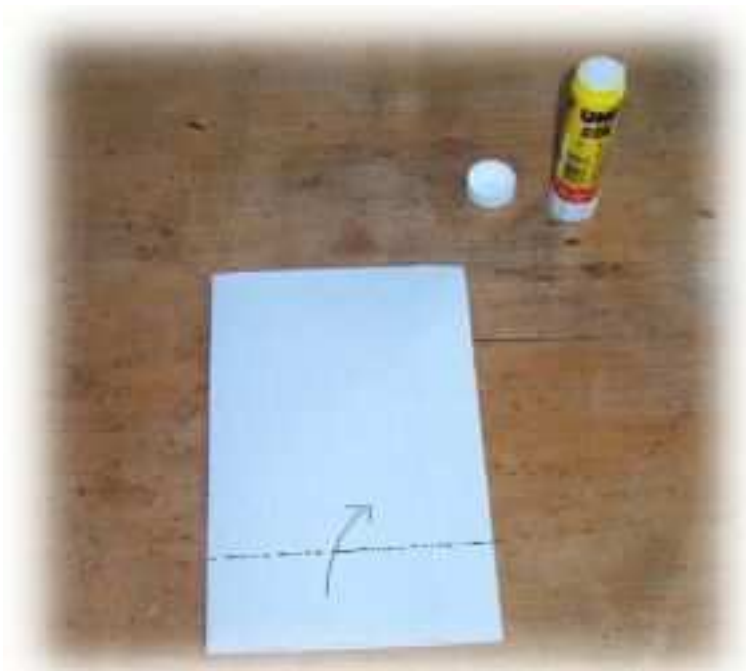
Lay a piece of paper as shown in front of you. Here Paper shown in DIN A4.



Fold the left side to the right, leaving a stripe of 2 cm like indicated in the picture



Fold this 2 cm stripe to the left and fix it by glueing.



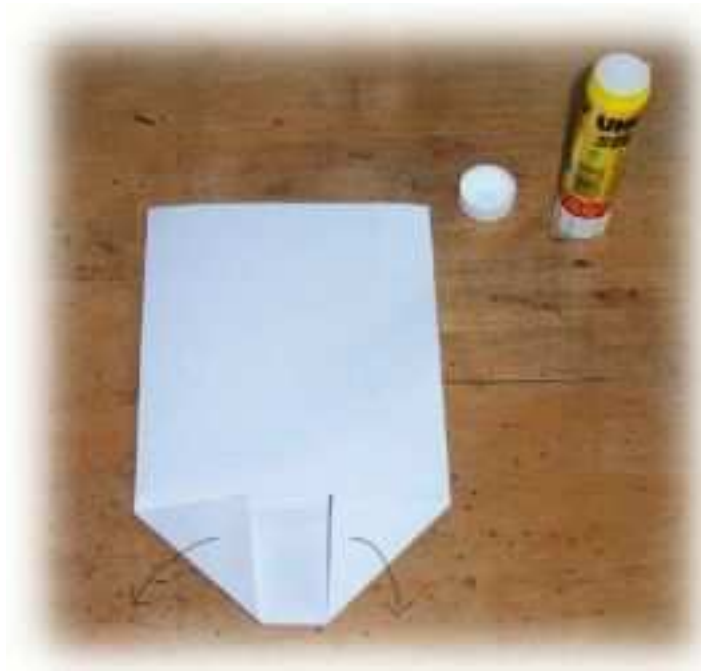
Fold ca. 5 cm to the top and fold it back



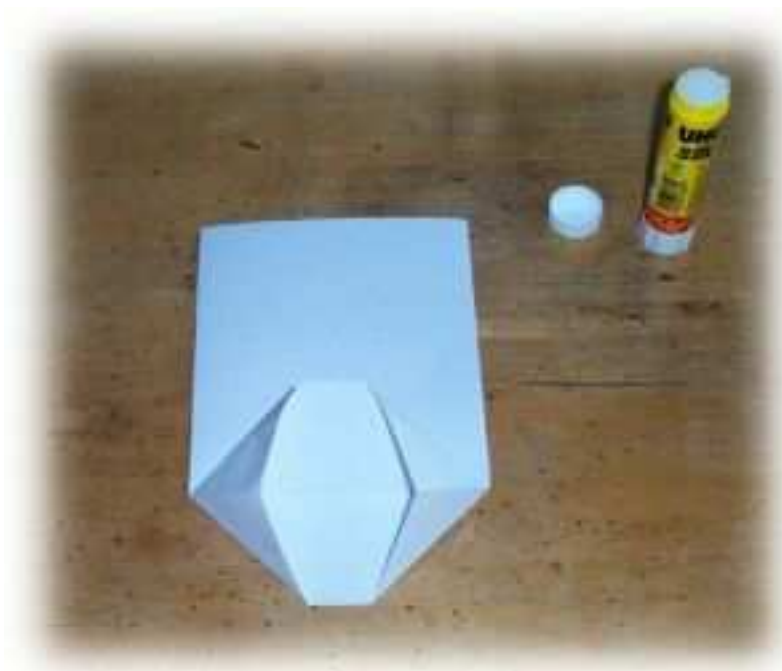
Fold the left corner in a right angle to the foldingline



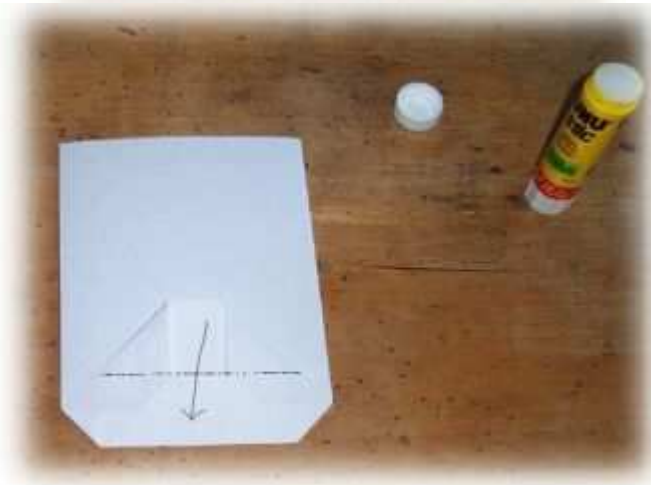
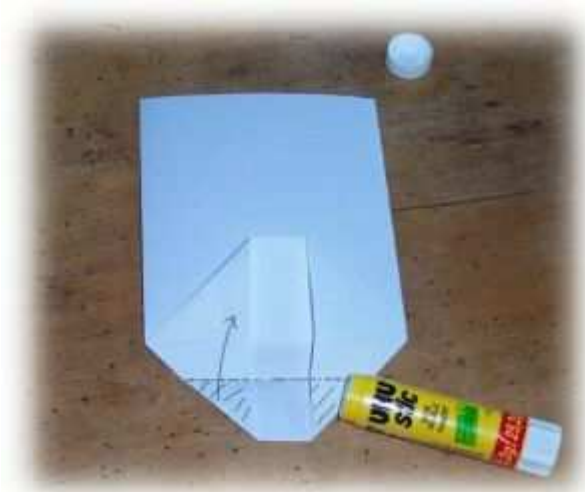
Repeat with the right side.



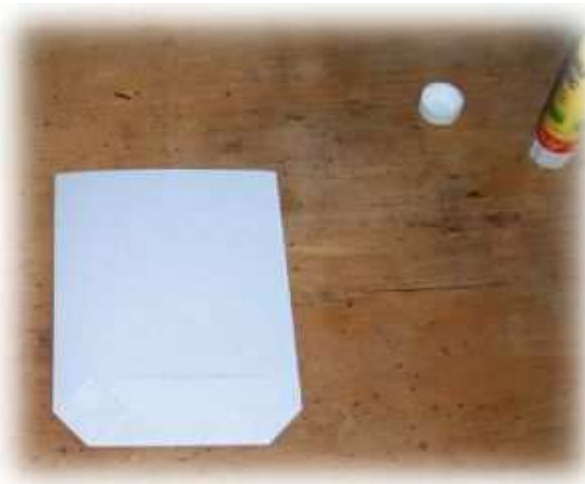
Fold the corners back. Go into the Paper and open like shown in the picture.



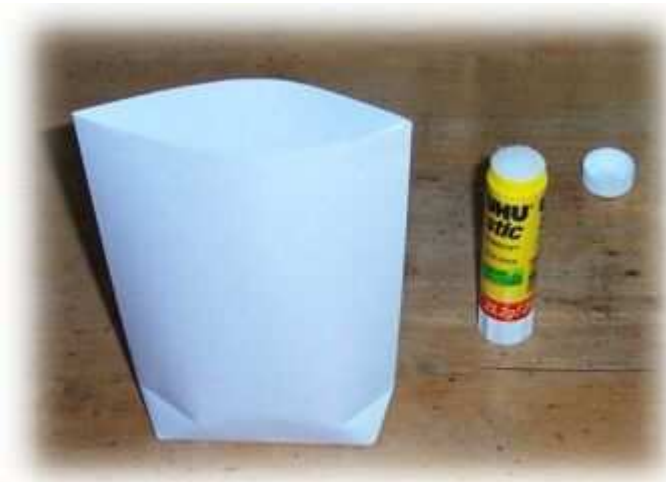
Fold from bottom a little bit more over the middleline. Fix by glueing. glue only on the with pencil signed places, otherwise there wood be glue on the bags floor inside.



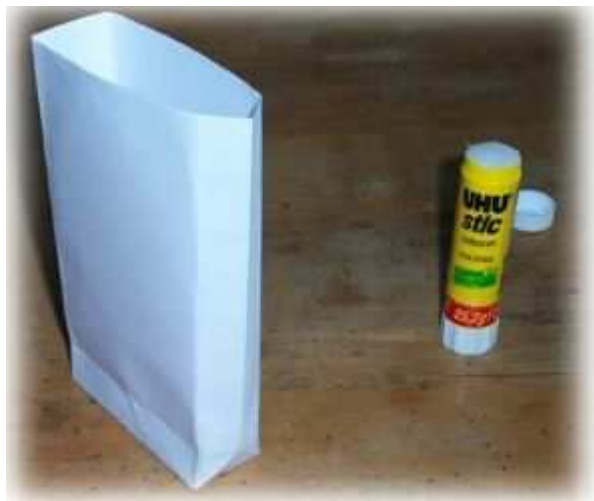
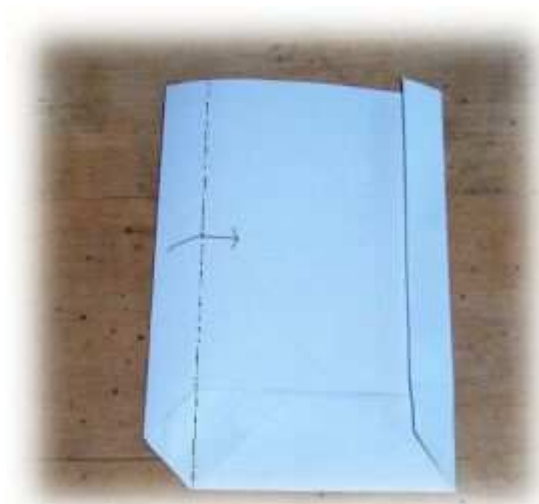
Repeat with the other side. Here glue the whole part of paper.



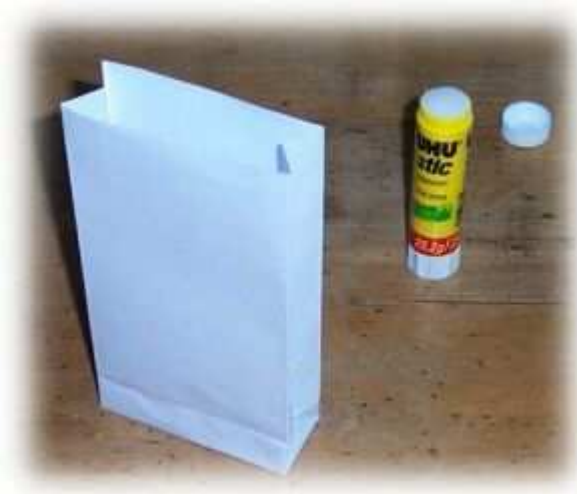
After drying you can open the bag.



Fold a pleat in the sideparts follow the instuction shown in the following pictures



Push the pleats inside to the bag.



Done!

If you want to have a stronger edge at the opening, fold like shown 2 cm . The bag will be shorter than, but stronger.
